

# A message from our Director

**Fiscal Year 2021 was a year of recovery for our organization. We often refer to it as our COVID recovery year. We were not opened at full capacity and things looked so different in every aspect of our organization. Despite the challenges we were faced with, we managed to stay afloat throughout the year and continue our mission.**

**We did have some amazing successes during the year including:**

- **Hitting 2 million in sales in our ReStore since opening;**
- **Having our highest ever March sales month since opening;**
- **Served 4 households through our Home Repair Program;**
  - **3 Projects in Indian River**
  - **1 Project in Cheboygan**
- **Started our 5th Home Repair Project;**
- **ReStore back in the positive after 4 years;**
- **Increased support by 59% with a slight increase (28%) in expenses.**

**We were not sure how COVID was truly going to play out, but we are so excited for what the future has in store for us. Together, with you, we are building and serving our local community!**




